- (b) Examine 'Elegy written in a Country Churchyard' as a pastoral elegy.
- (c) Discuss the complex nature of the Divine in Blake's 'The Lamb' and 'The Tyger'.
2. Locate and annotate any *one* of the following in about 200 words: 5×1 = 5
- (a) And I made a rural pen,
And I stain'd the water clear,
- (b) Some village Hampden, that with dauntless breast
The little tyrant of his fields withstood;
Some mute inglorious Milton here may rest,
Some Cromwell guiltless of his country's blood.
- (c) Grant me, kind Heaven, to find some happier place,
Where Honesty and sense are no disgrace
Some pleasing Bank where verdant Osiers play,
Some peaceful Vale with Nature's paintings gay;

3. Answer any *one* of the following questions in about 500 words: 15×1 = 15
- (a) Analyse Swift's use of irony in *Gulliver's Travels*. Answer with particular reference to Books III and IV.
- (b) Houyhnhnms' society is, in stark contrast even to the societies of Gulliver's third voyage, devoid of human elements. Discuss this statement in reference to Book III and IV of *Gulliver's Travels*.
4. Answer any *one* of the following questions in about 500 words: 15×1 = 15
- (a) Comment on the significance of the Proviso scene in Congreve's *The Way of the World*.
- (b) Discuss Congreve's *The Way of the World* as a representative Restoration comedy.
