- (b) Write a note on Coleridge's imagery in 'Kubla Khan'.
- (c) Show how the poet and prophet become one in Shelley's 'Ode to the West Wind'.
- (d) What is the central theme of Keats' poem, 'Ode on a Grecian Urn'?
2. Explain with reference to the context, any *two* of the following in about 200 words each: 5×2 = 10
- (a) It was a miracle of rare device,  
A sunny pleasure-dome with caves of ice!
- (b) While here I stand, not only with the sense  
Of present pleasure, but with pleasing thoughts  
That in this moment there is life and food  
For future years.
- (c) Heard melodies are sweet, but those unheard  
Are sweeter; therefore, ye soft pipes, play on;
- (d) Make me thy lyre, even as the forest is:  
What if my leaves are falling like its own!

3. Answer any *one* from the following questions in about 400 words: 10×1 = 10
- (a) Comment on the use of autobiographical elements by Charles Lamb in 'Dream Children' or 'The Superannuated Man'.
- (b) How does Thomas de Quincey distinguish between the 'literature of knowledge' and the 'literature of power'? Answer with reference to the text prescribed in your syllabus.
